## APRS SSID's

SSID's, Secondary Station Identifiers, were developed and promoted some years ago by Bob Bruninga, WB4APR.

They were intended to allow operators a means to identify a station that was not their main or base station.

When using APRS, operators are encouraged to use these SSID's as for 'normal' packet radio applications.

Icons are also available in the software programs to match the SSID's.
