I run Winpack on WIN7 Home premium, no troubles at all.

However if it won't install from the setup disc, but you have a working one on WINXP.

Copy and drag and drop to WIN7 and run as administrator.

Just right click on the packet.exe and select properties and click on run as administrator.

This message is sent from Win Home 32bit, but the PRO version will not?

I installed it immediately I had installed Windows, so as to not confuse it with other installed programs.

I rely on feedback from Winpack users.  
I do not use Winpack myself, so rely on the feedback from my user base to assist others or how to configure their systems.

The other important thing the \winpac directory should be under the C:\ directory and not Program Files.  
i.e.

Ok on your 32bit version of Win7 Home.

My Shack Laptop is Win7pro 64Bit and my 16 and 32 bit packet programs are running under the windows virtual PC/Windows XP mode. Including PaKet 6.2 16Bit DOS program
