OUTLOOK EXPRESS TIPS

NNTP

When using Microsoft express to POST news articles on the amprnet

Please remember to specify the correct DISTRIBUTION entry.

As this is used to determine where to route your words of wisdom when it is gateway'd from TCP/IP NNTP to AX25_BBS.

You can locate the Headers to change when selecting

Select news group

COMPOSE MESSAGE or NEW POST

NEW MESSAGE screen

Select VIEW

Select ALL HEADERS (this will now display all headers for your news article that you are preparing)

and enter in the Distribution field in lower case, each time you send a news article.

uk	(for all news articles destined for United Kingdom (@GBR)
europa	(for all news articles destined for Europe (@EU)
world	(for all news articles destined for World (@WW)
london	(for all news articles destined for London (@LONDON) network

SMTP

To send message to Amateur Radio Stations on tcp/ip (amprnet) the format is e. g.

sp g9bff@gb7###. ampr. org

to send a message from the amprnet TCP/IP network to be gateway back to AX25

eg

callsign%gb7xyz. #98. gbr. eu@gb7cip. ampr. org

callsign%vk1abc. cam. aus. oc@gb7cip. ampr. org

You MUST use the correct full address for the ax25_bbs and tcpip hostnames so that GB7CIP can gateway your TCP/IP and AX25 messages and bulletins automatically.
