Hi All, I from time-to-time see request's for info on the Storno series of PMR rigs which are starting to make an appearance at rallies. So in an attempt to stop people buying the wrong model for the band they want to use (or worst still one which can't go on any of our bands).

I have made a list of the different models.

Please note the Model No./Options No./Serial No. should be on the side of the rig (If it's not BEWARE). In all case's the rigs are 99 channel capable of ctcss encode and 1750 Hz tone burst.
